



PACKING ADVICE

CLIMATE

The Kimberley is a semi-tropical region experiencing two distinctive seasons, the 'Wet' and the 'Dry'. You can expect warm, balmy days with minimal rainfall and cool, starry nights during our cruise season.

DRESS CODE

We advise guests to pack four to five changes of casual comfortable clothing.

Excursions

Light-weight and quick-dry clothing for excursions is recommended. This includes a few pairs of shorts, T-shirts, a long-sleeved shirt and pair of light-weight pants that offer protection against the sun.

Footwear

There is no dress code for dining as a rule, generally 'Kimberley casual' attire for evenings is recommended.

PACKING LIST

Clothing

- *T-shirts/Blouses:* Short-sleeved, quick drying and sun protected
- *Long-sleeved Shirts:* Quick drying, sun-protected and breathable (limited stock available for purchase on-board)
- *Jumper/Jacket:* Suitable for cooler nights (limited stock available for purchase on-board)
- *Shorts:* Loose, quick-drying and comfortable
- *Pants:* Long, light-weight and comfortable
- *Wet Shoes:* Reef shoes or equivalent with good ankle support
- *Dry Shoes:* Enclosed walking shoes (sneakers) Shoes / Sandals (for onboard and scenic excursions)
- Sleep wear, undergarments and socks
- Bathing suits for swimmers / Sarong
- Wide-brim hat (available for purchase on-board)
- Polarised sunglasses

LUGGAGE & LAUNDRY

When packing for your Kimberley cruise we recommend that all passengers pack lightly and into one soft luggage bag.

Guests joining us on a cruise itinerary with a light aircraft transfer will be limited to a 10kg per person luggage allowance, as weight restrictions apply.

Please keep in mind that your bags will be weighed before departure. Any luggage which exceeds the 10kg per person allowance can be stored in our Broome office. For guests who require to take hand luggage with them please ensure the combined weight does not exceed 10kg.

All cruise itineraries *not including* a light aircraft transfer have a baggage allowance of 20kg per person.

Excess Luggage

Excess luggage may be stored free of charge in our secure office located in Broome. Please advise us before your departure if you require storage.

Laundry Facilities

Laundry facilities are available on-board free of charge. Please use the linen bags provided in your cabin and our hostesses will return your clean items to your cabin.

TOILETRIES & MEDICATIONS

We provide shampoo, conditioner and body wash on-board all cruises however you may wish to bring your own. We do require you to bring your own private toiletries which include:

- Personal toiletries/hygiene items (we provide hair-dryers)
- Prescription medication / Vitamins / Motion sickness preventative
- Chapstick / Sun protection (sunscreen is provided on-board)
- Insect repellent (Repellent spray is provided on-board)

ADDITIONAL ITEMS

You may also wish to bring

- Camera, batteries, memory stick and charger
- Binoculars - for the keen bird watcher and viewing rock art in hard to reach places
- iPod, personal music
- Water bottle (stainless steel bottle provided on-board)
- Small backpack to take on excursions
